

RockWare Network License Administrator Usage Log

The RockWare Network License Administrator writes a "UseageLog.txt" file which you can use to glean the user access to the license. This file is created on the server in C:\ProgramData\RockWare\License. The format looks like this:

The fields represent:

- Current DateTime on Server (local time)
- Command (see below)
- License ID (see below)
- Person ID (see below)
- User (Domain user)
- Machine (Domain computer)
- Start (DateTime of checkout) in UTC time

DateTime format: yyyymmdd:hhmmss

Commands:

Invalid (invalid request),

Alive (heart beat),

Checkout,

Checkin,

Borrow (Request to borrow/loan a license),

Return (Return a borrowed/loaned a license),

Quit (Request to Disconnect from the server),

Status (Request of Status of Licenses),

ReqStatus (Request of Status of the pending license requests),

Request (Request for Installation number),

Activate (Activate a license),

Remove (Request a removal code),

DelRequest (Delete a request for Installation number),

Property (Setting a Server property)

License Id:

RockWorks 17 = 17 LogPlot 8 = 8 PetraSim = 19

RockWorks 20x = 20 LogPlot 20x = 9

Person Id: arbitrary number assigned when connected to server, remains the same during the licensed session. A new checkout - a new number.
