

LogPlot8: Forcing Installation

LogPlot always installs as a demo or "trial" version. The trial eventually times out unless you activate a license, either using an unlocking code (Single license) or by connecting to a Network license on your server.


If you uninstall the demo, you are then prevented from re-installing LogPlot8 without forcing the program to ignore the fact that it was installed previously and that the 2-week trial period from before has timed out.

Here's how to force it to install:

- 1. **Download** the installer for LogPlot8 from our website, if you haven't already.
 - If your maintenance is current: Download the most recent update the Product Updates page: https://www.rockware.com/support/logplot-support/logplot-downloads/logplot-product-updates/
 - If your maintenance has expired: Pick the last-posted revision prior to the expiration of your
 maintenance from our Archives Page:
 https://www.rockware.com/support/logplot-support/logplot-downloads/logplot-archived-versions/

Be sure to save the installer file to your local computer.

- Using Windows File Explorer, locate the installer file you just downloaded, possibly in your Downloads folder.
 - If your maintenance is current: The installer will be named "logplot8_64_installation.exe" (64-bit) or "logplot8_installation.exe" (32-bit)
 - If your maintenance has expired: The installer will be named "logplot8_64_installation_yyyy_mm_dd.exe" (64-bit) or "logplot8_installation_yyyy_mm_dd.exe" (32-bit) where yyyy_mm_dd is the date of the revision.
- 3. Right-click on that file and choose Create Shortcut.






- 4. Right-click on the new Shortcut and select Properties.
- 5. Click on the **Shortcut** tab.
- 6. Edit the "Target"

from: \((path)\logplot8_64_installation.exe\)
to: \((path)\logplot8\) 64 installation.exe /force=true

being sure that there is a space between "exe" and "/force" It should look something like this:



- 7. Click **Apply**, and click **OK** to apply the changes and close the shortcut properties window.
- 8. **Double-click on the shortcut** to run the installer AND force it to ignore the expired trialware date. You can accept the installation defaults.
- 9. When the installation is complete, **start** the program.
- 10. Follow the instructions, provided separately, for setting up your license.
