

Quick Start - LogPlot 7, Network User

Obtaining the Certificate File

The network version requires installation of a "certificate file" that is supplied separately. Save this certificate file into a folder on the network to which all clients have read and write access. Contact RockWare for details.

Installing LogPlot 7

Network Administrator: The LogPlot program should be installed onto each client computer.

1. Visit www.rockware.com.
 2. Click on the **Downloads** menu item, along the top of the page, and select **Product Updates**.
 3. Click on the **LogPlot** link.
 4. Scroll down to the **LogPlot7** heading and click the **Download LogPlot7** button.
 5. **Save** the installation file to your computer.
 6. When the download is complete, **run** the installation file ("logplot7_install.exe") to start the installation. Follow the recommended installation settings.
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Licensing LogPlot 7

When installation is complete, the licensing program will start automatically.

1. Read the license agreement and, if you accept the terms listed, click in the ***I accept the terms of this agreement*** check-box.
 2. Now, specify who you are. To set up the licensing for the Network version, you must be either an ***Administrator*** or an ***End-User*** with administrator privileges. Click the appropriate button in the upper part of the screen.
 3. Select the type of license you purchased: Click ***Network*** under Licensing Options.
 4. Click the ***Continue*** button at the bottom of the screen.
 5. Enter the licensing information:
 - Type your organization's name into the ***Licensee Name*** prompt.
 - Type the Registration Number (printed on a sticker on the user manual, CD and registration card, and included on your contract) into the ***Registration Number*** prompt.
 - Browse to the location of the ***Certificate File***, as described above, and click the ***Continue*** button.
 - Into the ***Network User ID*** prompt, type in your name or other unique identifying string. The ID string is limited to 20 characters, including spaces. Your ID will be stored in the certificate file while you are using the program. When you exit LogPlot, your ID will be logged out of the certificate file. The certificate file will allow a specific number of unique users to log in at a time; if you purchased a 5-seat license, then 5 unique ID's are allowed to be logged in at any one time.
 6. Click ***Continue***. The LogPlot program window will be displayed and, along the right, the program Help messages.
 7. We recommend you take the time to go through a few of the tutorial lessons, by clicking on the ***Tutorial*** button at the top of the Help window.
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Getting Help

- Level 1: Run through the **Tutorial** lessons in the online Help window which is displayed upon program start and via the Help / Tutorial menu.
 - Level 2: Select the Help/Contents option to access the Help messages for LogPlot. They are also available by clicking the Help button in most program Options windows.
 - Level 3: Visit our **web site**, www.rockware.com and click on the Support | LogPlot menu.
 - Level 4: Join the online **support forum** where users post questions and answers. This is available via the Support page mentioned above.
