

## **RockWorks20: Forcing Installation**

RockWorks always installs as a demo or "trial" version. The trial eventually times out unless you activate a license, either using an unlocking code (Single or Time-limited licenses) or by connecting to a Network license on your server.


If you uninstall the demo, you may be prevented from re-installing RockWorks20 without forcing the program to ignore the fact that it was installed previously and that the 2-week trial period from before has timed out.

Here's how to force it to install:

- 1. **Download** the installer for RockWorks20 from our website, if you haven't already.
  - If your maintenance is current: Download the most recent update the Product Updates page: <a href="https://www.rockware.com/support/rockworks-support/rockworks-downloads/rockworks-product-updates/">https://www.rockware.com/support/rockworks-support/rockworks-downloads/rockworks-product-updates/</a>
  - If your maintenance has expired: Pick the last-posted revision prior to the expiration of your maintenance from our Archives Page: <a href="https://www.rockware.com/support/rockworks-support/rockworks-downloads/rockworks-archived-versions/">https://www.rockware.com/support/rockworks-support/rockworks-downloads/rockworks-archived-versions/</a>

Be sure to save the installer file to your local computer.

- 2. Using **Windows File Explorer**, locate the installer file you just downloaded, possibly in your Downloads folder.
  - If your maintenance is current: The installer will be named "rockworks20\_installation.exe"
  - If your maintenance has expired: The installer will be named "rockworks20\_installation\_yyyy\_mm\_dd.exe" where yyyy\_mm\_dd is the date of the revision.
- 3. Right-click on that file and choose Create Shortcut.






- 4. Right-click on the new Shortcut and select Properties.
- 5. Click on the **Shortcut** tab.
- 6. Edit the "Target"

from: \((path)\\rockworks20\_installation.exe\)
to: \((path)\\rockworks20\) installation.exe /force=true

being sure that there is a space between "exe" and "/force" It should look something like this:



- 7. Click **Apply**, and click **OK** to apply the changes and close the shortcut properties window.
- 8. **Double-click on the shortcut** to run the installer AND force it to ignore the expired trialware date. You can accept the installation defaults.
- 9. When the installation is complete, **start** the program.
- 10. Follow the instructions, provided separately, for setting up your license.
