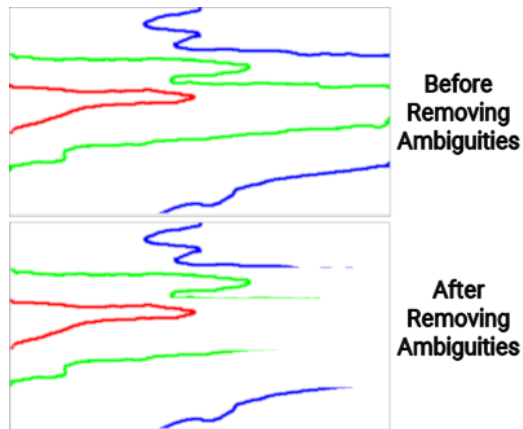


When curves go off-scale and wrap, spikes may appear within the output due to overlap (i.e., portions of two curves occupying the same row of pixels). As a consequence, erratic spikes may occur within the output inside the overlapping zone. The *Remove Ambiguities* option will temporarily change the overlapping zone within the *Inferior* curve to white thereby removing the erratic spikes.



The disambiguation colors are set by clicking on the associated color button and then clicking on a curve within the log.

Note: The Preview option can take some time, depending up the resolution of the raster image. This process, however, can be aborted by selecting the *Cancel* button. The Remove Ambiguities will also slow down the processing that occurs after the user has clicked the *Continue* button.
